Please observe these 5 important safety subjects and tips below.

ALARMS and SPRINKLERS

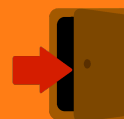


- 🔥 Don't disarm or remove batteries from smoke alarms
- 🔥 Don't cover or hang things on sprinklers, which can hinder their effectiveness

*You will be fined for tampering with smoke detectors or sprinklers.



ESCAPE PLAN



- 🔥 Always know two ways out of your building
- 🔥 Close your door to protect yourself and keep fire from spreading
- 🔥 Do not block hallways and keep exits clear



SMOKING

- 🔥 Always smoke outside and put it all the way out before you discard the butt
- 🔥 Use large, sturdy ashtrays placed on an inflammable surface

*Smoking of any kind is prohibited in Reed College housing. Violations will result in a fine.



COOKING

- 🔥 Cook only where permitted and never leave food cooking unattended
- 🔥 If a fire starts in the microwave, keep the door shut and unplug the unit



CANDLES



* Burning candles is prohibited in Reed College housing. Violations will result in a fine.
When burning candles off campus...

- 🔥 Make sure candles are in sturdy holders and put out after each use
- 🔥 Never leave a burning candle unattended
