The <u>International Programs Office</u> (IPO) and the <u>Art Department</u> at Reed College invite applications for an exciting opportunity to create an original artwork (7 7/8 by 10 3/4 inches (200 mm × 273 mm) inspired by one of the countries, cities, or universities where Reed has a study abroad or exchange program. Attached is an image from The New Yorker, which illustrates the type of design the IPO and the Art Department are looking for. The proposed themes for spring 2025 are:

- Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan)
- Lille (France)

We are seeking a creative and enthusiastic student artist who can bring their unique perspective to this project. Their design will celebrate the global connections of the Reed community and will be showcased as part of the International Programs Office's outreach and events. This is a paid position at the Reed student wage rate of \$15.95 per hour (estimated 10-15 hours of work for each artwork).
